Your 2017–2018 California Dream Act Application was selected for review in a process called Verification. The law says that before awarding State funds, we may ask you to confirm the information you and your parents reported on the Dream Application. To verify that you provided correct information, the financial aid administrator at your school will compare your Dream Act Application with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your Dream Act Application information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Enrollment Services Office. If you have questions about verification, contact the Enrollment Services Office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

What You Should Do

1. If you or your parent(s) are tax filers, obtain a **2015 IRS Tax Return Transcript** for yourself and your parent(s). The Enrollment Services Office cannot accept preparer’s copies of the required tax documents. You may request an **IRS TAX Return Transcript** online at www.irs.gov/Individuals/Get-Transcript or by phone at 1-800-908-9946. Make sure you select an **IRS Tax Return Transcript** and NOT the IRS Tax Account Transcript.
2. Complete all sections of this worksheet – you and one of your parents must sign this worksheet.
3. Submit the completed worksheet, tax return transcript(s) and any other required documents to the Enrollment Services Office.

B. Dependent Student’s Family Information

You will need to list the people in your parent(s)’ household. Include:

- Yourself and your parent(s) (including a stepparent), even if you don’t live with your parent(s).
- Your parent(s)’ other children if your parent(s) will provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2018. Include children who meet these standards, even if they do not live with your parent(s).
- Other people if they now live with your parent(s), and your parent(s) provide more than half of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support through June 30, 2018.
- List the name of the college, for any household member, excluding your parent(s), who will be enrolled at least half time in a degree, diploma, or certificate program at a postsecondary educational institution any time between July 1, 2017, and June 30, 2018.

c. Dependent Student's Income Information to Be Verified

1. TAX RETURN FILERS—Important Note: If you filed, or will file an **amended** 2015 IRS tax return, you must submit a signed copy of the IRS Form 1040X that was filed, **and** a Tax Return Transcript or a signed copy of the original tax return that was filed.

You will need your Social Security number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS (normally this will be the address used when the 2015 IRS tax return was filed).
