- Form N-550 or N-570 "Certificate of Naturalization" This document must be issued by the USCIS and include your name, certificate number, Alien Registration Number, name of the court that issued naturalization and date of naturalization.

Proof of Eligible Non-Citizenship status:

- Form I-151 or I-551 which must include valid expiration date
- Form I-94 or I-94A with the endorsement "Processed for I-551, Temporary Evidence of Lawful Admission for Permanent Residence. Valid until (MM/DD/YYYY). Employment Authorized." This form is acceptable if the expiration date has not passed.
- MIRV (Migrant Visa) with a statement "upon endorsement serves as temporary I- 551 evidencing permanent residence for 1 year" contained in an unexpired foreign passport is valid for 1 year from date of endorsement.
