Individuals Granted a Filing Extension by the IRS

If a **filing extension** was granted by the IRS beyond the automatic six months: You must also provide the following:

- A copy of the **IRS's approval** of an extension for the tax year 2023
- A signed statement listing the sources of any 2023 income and the amount of income from each source
- A copy of IRS Form W-2 for each source of employment income received or an equivalent document for the tax year 2023
- If self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of Adjusted Gross Income and U.S. income tax paid for the year 2023

Individuals Who Filed an Amended IRS Income Tax Return

If an Amended IRS income tax return was filed, you must provide a signed copy of the 2023 IRS Form 1040X, "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS or documentation from the IRS that include the change(s) made by the IRS, **and** one of the following:

- Updated income and tax information from the IRS on an ISIR record with all tax information from the original tax return
- A 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript (that will only include information from the original tax return and does not have to be signed), or any other IRS tax transcript(s) that includes all of the income and tax information required to be verified; or
- A signed copy of the 2023 IRS Form 1040 and the applicable schedule that were filed with the IRS

Individuals Who Were Victims of IRS Tax-Related Identity Theft

An individual who was the victim of IRS tax-related identity theft must provide the following:

- A Tax Return DataBase View (TRDBV) transcript obtained from the IRS or, if unable to obtain a TRDBV, an equivalent document provided by the IRS or a copy of the signed 2023 income tax return and applicable schedules the individual filed with the IRS; **and**
- A statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that they were a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS is aware of the tax-related identity theft.
