

COM Identity Verification - Financial Aid

All FAFSA applicants at College of Marin are required to verify their identity.

You must appear in person at the Enrollment Services Office to verify your identity by presenting an unexpired valid identification document. The following documents are acceptable:

- Passport
- Driver's License
- Military ID
- State ID
- Tribal ID
- COM or Other College ID
- High School ID
- Official High School Transcript (Sealed or Stamped)

If you are <u>unable to appear in person</u>, you may mail the <u>original signed and notarized</u> statement of Identity along with a copy of the unexpired valid government-issued photo ID that is acknowledged in the **notary statement** below. *The completed worksheet must be mailed to the address noted on the bottom of this form.*
